**FLC 1, Daryl Hayes, “The Non-Beatitude’s”-** It is often said that, “attitude is everything.” In the Sermon on the Mount Jesus clearly sets forth a few attitudes that are admirable. Paul wrote in Philippians that we should have the same attitude of Jesus. This quarter we will identify some attitudes Jesus never exhibited and the Bible condemns. These attitudes can easily slip into our lives and become destructive to our relationships, Christ-like character, and our ability to witness for Him. After we identify each of these attitudes we will seek practical things we can do to eliminate them from our lives.

**FLC 2, Lanny Seals, “Who's Who in the Bible” -** Ever wonder who the minor prophets were, who were the Kings of Israel, etc? This class will use various lists to study the famous, the infamous, the well known and obscure characters in the Bible.

**FLC DR, Dave Hammonds, “1 John” -** No one knew Jesus better than his best friend, the apostle John. In this letter John deals with fellowship, false teachers, faith, hope and love.

**E116, Randy Everett, “Mind The Gap”-** (Note: this class begins Sept. 12) Jesus said those who follow him are to be the salt that seasons the world and the light that pushes back the darkness. Many of us don't feel very salty and we sometimes wonder if we are shining or flickering like a candle in the Oklahoma winds. Come and see what Jesus taught the crowds on the hills of Galilee about life that is satisfying and glows brightly. Join us for lessons from the one who bridged the gap, and learn what Michelangelo, the London underground, the garden of Eden, and your next door neighbor all have in common.

**FLC 1, Jody Burch, “Peace Making” –** “Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall see God.” These words of Christ are part of the central foundation of what it means to follow him, yet conflict exists in many relationships around us. Each class will be a combination of video presentation and class discussion. Liz, a converted atheist, is a marvelous example of the transforming power of God. The purpose of this series of lessons is to understand how God works through his word and the Holy Spirit transforming our minds which enables us to become a living testimony of the glorious presence, character and power of God.
