**FLC-1, Ray Patton, "The Gospel Goes to the Movies"** – In this class, we will take a look at the intersection of faith & film, and how movies often serve as modern-day parables. Using different movies from week to week, we will explore some of the themes in the life and teachings of Jesus that can be found on the Big Screen.

**FLC-2, Daryl Hayes, "Cross-Shaped Lives"** - So you go to church and try to be a "good" person. Is that really all it means to be a Christian? What does being a Christian look like in real life?
